Lessing describes how communism dominated the intellectual life of the 1950s, and evokes the bohemian days of a young single mother, her writing process, her friends and lovers, her involvement in the theater, and her political activities. Awarded the Nobel in 2007, Lessing (1919-2013) was one of the most celebrated and distinguished writers of our time, receiving the Somerset Maugham Award, the David Cohen Memorial Prize for British Literature, the James Tait Black Prize, Spain's Prix Catalunya and Prince of Asturias Prize, and a dozen other prestigious literary awards. 405.
