Excerpt from The Odontographic Journal, 1895, Vol. 16 We have no hesitancy in stating that the process of shedding the temporary teeth is a purely physiological one; though it has been suggested by some writers of later date than those referred to, that inflammation in a more or less marked degree, is present during the accomplishment of this work. This we cannot accept as yet proven; and may state that in a great majority of cases there is no indication whatever of inflammation, or even special irritation. It is true that oftentimes local disease of more or less marked character is concurrent with shedding the teeth; but that it occurs as a necessary result of the removal of the roots of the temporary teeth, we think, there is no evidence. In the plan of the human organism the temporary teeth are to be displaced to make way for the permanent; and it would seem to be unreasonable that diseased inaction, even in the mildest form, should be called in to aid in the accomplishment of this work.
